

International art fair Fine Art Asia returns this week! On display are **artworks spanning**5,000 years of cultural history, from ancient Chinese bronzes to contemporary art. The focus will be on Hong Kong's excellent art and antique galleries, as well as its outstanding art institutions. Some of these include Rasti Chinese Art, which will present a large lacquered and gessoed camphor wood head of a guardian, Dvarapala, dating around the Ming dynasty.

Rossi & Rossi will exhibit Chinese and Himalayan works of art, while Maria Kiang
